

School District of Cadott Community Hall of Honor

What does it take to become a member of the Cadott Hall of Honor?

This is a person/team/organization who has made significant accomplishments; either while in school or outside of school, either as a student, player, member of an organization, teacher, coach, booster, etc. that our community and school can be proud of. These positive accomplishments need to be of the type our current students should consider aspiring to. By honoring these individuals and groups we hope to deepen the understanding and appreciation of the contributions made by them, so that they may serve as an inspiration and role models for the student body as well as the community at large.

Who is eligible?

- Nominees must be a graduate of Cadott High School or an individual who has made significant contributions to the success of the School District of Cadott Community and the residents of the district.
 - Alumni of Cadott High School will be considered 15 years after their graduation from Cadott High School.
 - Residents of the Cadott Community who did not graduate from Cadott Community Schools will be eligible after 25 years of residency in the community.
- Alumni nominees will be evaluated in any of the following areas:
 - Academics
 - Athletics
 - Business
 - Civic Duty
 - Fine Arts
 - Sciences
 - Other _____
- All state championship teams are eligible for nomination to the Hall of Honor and will be considered and recognized as a group nomination. Individuals on those teams remain eligible for nomination for their individual accomplishments.
- Staff, coaches, boosters, community members, etc. will be considered for their personal and/or professional efforts in promoting the success of the School District of Cadott Community and its students.
- All nominees will be evaluated on their worthiness to serve as a model of success and character that our students will admire and emulate. The Selection Committee reserves the right to rescind membership from a member of the Cadott Hall of Honor for any indiscretion deemed unworthy of continued recognition by the Cadott Hall of Honor.
- Only individuals/teams/organizations with nomination papers on file by the annual deadline will be considered.
- No more than 3 nominees will be inducted into the Hall of Honor in any given year. All nominations received by the Hall of Honor Selection Committee will remain on file for annual review for 5 years unless renominated.

How is a nomination made?

Nominations are due by March 1st of each year to the principal of Cadott Senior High School. Nomination letters should include all information that you want considered regarding the candidate including year graduated from Cadott High School (if applicable) and a listing of the significant positive high school and/or post-high school learning and life accomplishments of the individual/team/organization. A current picture of the individual/team/organization nominated and, if available, their senior picture (if a CHS graduate). Contact information (name, address, phone number) for the person nominating and the person being nominated needs to be included with the letter of nomination. You may nominate someone, self-nominate or someone else may nominate you. Nominations not selected in the year made are considered again the next year.

Who decides who is recognized?

A committee chaired by the high school principal reviews the nominations, gathers additional information and makes the determination as to the individuals/teams/organizations that are recognized in a given year.

The voting committee is composed of the high school principal (chairperson), three School Board members, and the head of a local non-profit organization. The superintendent of schools is an optional voting committee member.

When is the person(s) recognized?

The Cadott High School principal will make the announcement during the high school graduation ceremony. The person to be recognized is invited to be present to receive the honor, and may be asked to address the new graduates (if willing) or if that is not possible they may have a family member or friend accept the honor for them or if no one can be present the honor will be announced and any certificates, plaques, etc., if possible, will be mailed to the recipient or made available for later pick up.
