### Kindergarten

- 2 packages washable Crayola Classic Color markers
- 6 packages **Crayola 24-count** crayons
- 1 scissors (Fiskars)
- 2 dozen or more large glue sticks (preferably Elmer's)
- 1 spiral notebook (wide ruled)
- 2 pocket folder – bottom pockets
- 1 headset (NO EAR BUDS PLEASE)
- 1 large backpack with name on it
- 1 fabric pencil case that zips
- 4 pink erasers (no pencil toppers)

**A change of clothes in a Ziplock bag with child's name. The bag should include: underpants, socks, shirt, and pants – no shorts.**
